

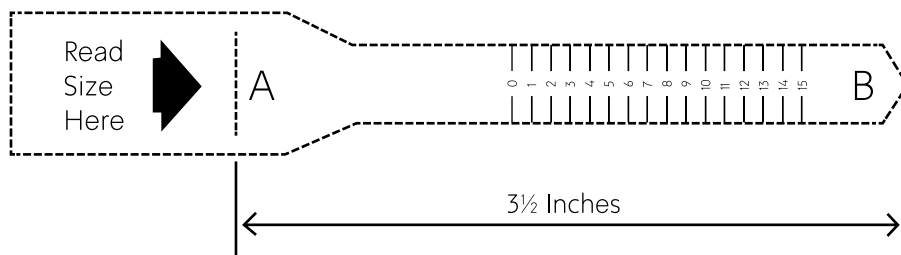
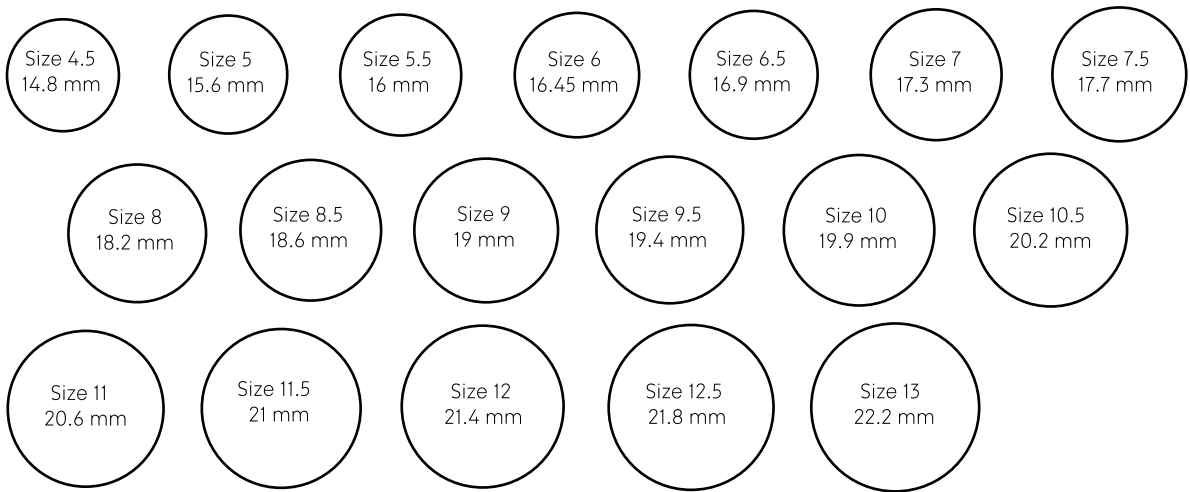
Find your ring size

If you are unsure of your ring size it is always best to visit a local jeweller for a professional sizing.

For the most accurate measurement:

Take your finger measurement at the end of the day in room temperature or warm temperatures. Cold temperatures make your finger smaller than normal. Take your knuckle size into consideration. If it is much larger than your finger, make sure to select a size that will allow room for the ring to slip over it comfortably while still fitting securely on your finger. Remember that your dominant hand's ring size can measure between a half and full size larger than your other hand.

String Measurement

Preparation: Using a small piece of string, wrap it around your finger snugly but comfortably.

Sizing: Then take the string and line it up with its corresponding circle on our sizing chart.

*It's best practice to take your measurement twice, taking care to not wrap the string too tight.

Paper Measurement

Print out our paper ring sizer below.

Preparation: To begin, carefully make a small slit in the paper along the dotted line where it says "ring size."

Sizing: Place the pointed end of the sizer through the slit you just made. The sizer should form a circle. Place the circle around your finger, using the pointed end to pull it snug. The number line measurement that now aligns with the word "ring size" is your size.

*As with the string measurement, it's best practice to take your measurement twice, taking care to not wrap the paper too tight.
